Excerpt from Report of the Board of Metropolitan Park Commissioners:

December, 1916 It seems wise. At this

time to call special attention to this phase of the work and submit recommendations in regard to it. The claims for practically all acquisitions of land had been settled before 1912. The few which remained unsettled were, for the most part, those as to which there was some defect of title or difficulty in

locating the persons entitled to payment. The Metropolitan Parks Loan, Series Two, appropriations for land acquired prior to 1912, has been exhausted. A claim for land acquired from the National Sailors' Home for Furnace Brook Parkway prior to that time remains unsatisfied, owing to delays beyond the power of this Board to control. This claim may now be settled for the sum of and an appropriation of that amount as an addition to Metropolitan Parks Loan, Series Two, is recommended.
