Like all introductory textbooks, Psychology covers a lot of material, and because

the material is scientific in nature, some of it can be difficult to understand and assimilate. A study guide is a helpful choice for college students, who are always pressed for time, to enhance comprehension. Although designed specifically to accompany Myers' textbook, this study guide would also be a useful companion for other psychology textbooks or for someone wanting a good basic review of psychology's concepts and terms.
