end consumer. Illustrating how operations relate to the rest of the organization, *Production and Operations Management Systems* provides an understanding of the production and operations management (P/OM) functions as well as the processes of goods and service producers. The modular character of the text permits many different journeys through the materials. If you like to start with supply chain management (Chapter 9) and then move on to
