On March 3, 1983, Peter Ivers was found  
bludgeoned to death in his loft in  
downtown Los Angeles, ending a short-  
lived but essential pop cultural moment  
that has been all but lost to history. For  
the two years leading up to his murder,  
Ivers had hosted the underground but

increasingly popular LA-based music and  
sketch-comedy cable show New Wave  
Theatre. The late '70s through early '80s  
was an explosive time for pop culture:  
Saturday Night Live and National  
Lampoon were leading a comedy  
renaissance, while punk rock and new  
wave were turning the music world on its  
head. New Wave Theatre brought  
together for the first time comedians-  
turned-Hollywood players like John  
Belushi, Chevy Chase, and Harold Ramis  
with West Coast punk rockers Black Flag,  
the Dead Kennedys, Fear, and others,  
thus transforming music and comedy  
forever. The show was a jubilant, chaotic  
punk-experimental-comedy cabaret, and  
Ivers was its charismatic leader and  
muse. He was, in fact, the only person  
with the vision, the generosity of spirit,  
and the myriad of talented friends to  
bring together these two very different  
but equally influential worlds, and with  
his death the improbable and electric  
union of punk and comedy came to an  
end. The magnetic, impishly brilliant  
Ivers was a respected musician and  
composer (in addition to several albums,  
he wrote the music for the centerpiece  
song of David Lynch's cult classic  
Eraserhead) whose sublime and bizarre  
creativity was evident in everything he  
did. He was surrounded by people who

loved him, many of them luminaries: his best friend from his Harvard days was Doug Kenney, founder of National Lampoon; he was also close to Harold Ramis and John Belushi. Upon his death, Ivers was just beginning to get mainstream recognition. In *Heaven Everything Is Fine* is the first book to explore both the fertile, gritty scene that began and ended with New Wave Theatre and the life and death of its guiding spirit. Josh Frank, author of *Fool the World: The Oral History of a Band Called Pixies*, interviewed hundreds of people from Ivers's circle, including Jello Biafra, Stockard Channing, and David Lynch, and we hear in their own words about Ivers and the marvelous world he inhabited. He also spoke with the Los Angeles Police Department about Ivers's still-unsolved murder, and, as a result of his research, the Cold Case Unit has reopened the investigation. In *Heaven Everything Is Fine* is a riveting account of a gifted artist, his tragic death, and a little-known yet crucial chapter in American pop history.

*Century* For the most part this work is a translation of Professor Pedersen's *Sprogvidenskaben i det Nittende Aarhundrede: Metoder og Resultater*, Copenhagen, Gyldendalske Boghandel, 1924, which appeared as Volume XV of *Det Nittende Aarhundrede*, an imposing series edited by Aage Friis and designed to present the cultural history of the nineteenth century in all its aspects. The relatively unimportant deviations from the original have been made either by the author or with his advice and consent. Scholarly works which have appeared since 1924, and are of such a nature as to affect the conclusions expressed in the original text, have been mentioned by the author in the translation; other changes include occasional amplification of a statement or the use of different examples. Word-forms thoroughly familiar to the Scandinavian reader might not be illuminating to the reader of an English translation, and therefore more

appropriate examples have been selected in place of those on page 272, the first paragraph of page 273, and most of the first paragraph of page 274 of the Danish text. The way of the translator is hard, as any one knows who has gone that way; especially hard when a work of a scholarly nature is involved, where extreme fidelity in translation is imperative. That way would not have been trod in the present instance if the translator had not thought he saw in the original certain cardinal virtues which would make the book a desirable addition to the English literature of linguistics. The problems, as well as the accomplishments, of the study of linguistics during this most important of centuries are faithfully and clearly recorded. Before each step in advance is described, the need for this step is pointed out, so that we have not merely a dry recital of events, but a story which gives us a series of living pictures of these pioneering intellects actually at work wrestling with problems the solution of which constitutes one chapter of the most stirring history we know, the history of the achievements of the human spirit in winning new knowledge. In spite of the tremendous advance in knowledge of the past century and a quarter, the results have not been incorporated in our general culture. Zamenhof, which will be complete and comprehensive in regards to a) the grammar of Esperanto as first outlined by Zamenhof in *Fundamento de Esperanto* and other foundational documents, and b) Esperanto as it is spoken today by the most committed Esperantists. (Proposed reforms to the Esperanto language will be discussed if they have serious support from a significant fraction of Esperanto enthusiasts). This book was started practically on a dare from the August 2006 issue of *Bob's Poetry Magazine*, in which Robert Happelberg boasted that he could print a complete and comprehensive grammar of Esperanto in just one 6 by 7 inch page. While this is obviously wrong, it's not too far off the mark. When completed, this book will require several standard size (8.5 by 11 in the USA) pages, but will still be much

shorter than a complete grammar of a natural language like English or Slovene. In view of this goal, the number of examples provided for each concept will be kept to a bare minimum. Those wishing to build their Esperanto vocabularies are also referred to the Esperanto textbooks. It is acceptable in the beginning to word the text in an accessible manner like in a textbook, but the goal should be for all the text to be technical with a full command of linguistic jargon.
