It was a period which produced some of the most profound and influential literary expressions of religious faith from John Milton's *Paradise Lost* and John Bunyan's *Pilgrim's Progress*, while simultaneously giving rise to a culture of libertinism and savage polemical satire, as well as fostering the new dispassionate discourses of experimental sciences and the conventions of popular romance.
