Esta obra tem por objetivo central investigar, a partir de um estudo transdisciplinar com a epistemologia e com a psicologia, cognitiva e comportamental, a existência de condições para o exercício da imparcialidade no Direito Processual Penal brasileiro e a (in)dispensabilidade da implementação do juiz de garantias trazida pela Lei no 13.964/2019 para atingir o referido objetivo. Investiga-se, em especial, a epistemologia da prova, as heurísticas e os vieses cognitivos capazes de afetar o julgador.
