Coal, still used to generate more than half

of the electric power in the U.S., will likely
be part of any future global energy plan.
But this finite resource is also responsible
for 80 percent of the CO2 emissions from
power production, and its continued use
will require improved processing
techniques that are less damaging to the
environment and less costly. One viable
option is the use of "clean coal" energy
conversion devices that rely on the
combustion of gasified coal, referred to as
synthesis gas, or syngas. *Synthesis Gas

Governments and companies around the world are devoting significant resources to improve understanding of the combustion of coal and bio-derived synthesis gases, to maximize the benefits of gasification technology and limit CO₂ emissions. This valuable reference provides state-of-the-art context and technical information needed to develop clean energy systems. These include clean coal technologies, hydrogen and liquid fuel production, use of biomass feedstocks, and usage in fuel cells and other advanced power generation technologies.

This book discusses manufactured carbon for the purposes of being a self-lubricating material for mechanical devices. Topics include; properties and graphite crystals, properties of manufactured carbon, the manufacture of carbon articles, machining carbon, carbon in mechanical seals, carbon in bearings, rotary pumps and motors, metering devices, and piston rings and cylinder liners.

The impact of outliers and heavy-tailed distributions on power and our ability to obtain an accurate assessment of how groups differ and variables are related is a practical concern when using standard techniques, regardless of how large the sample size

might be. Methods for dealing with this insight are described. The deleterious effects of heteroscedasticity on conventional ANOVA and regression methods are much more serious than once thought. Effective techniques for dealing with heteroscedasticity are described and illustrated. Requiring no prior training in statistics, *Modern Statistics for the Social and Behavioral Sciences* provides a graduate-level introduction to basic, routinely used statistical techniques relevant to the social and behavioral sciences. It describes and illustrates methods developed during the last half century that deal with known problems associated with classic techniques. Espousing the view that no single method is always best, it imparts a general understanding of the relative merits of various techniques so that the choice of method can be made in an informed manner.
