It has been written at the suggestion of the publisher, to accompany the Rudimentary Series, and as a first book on the Art of Building, intended for the use of young persons who are about to commence their professional training for any pursuit connected with the erection of buildings; and, also, for the use of amateurs who wish to obtain a general knowledge of the subject without devoting to it the time requisite for the study of the larger works that have been written on the different branches of construction. To avoid unnecessarily extending the limits of

The equilibrium of retaining walls is a subject which has long engaged the attention of mathematicians with little practical success, the results arrived at by different eminent writers being quite at variance with each other.
